HELP PAYING FOR YOUR CHILDCARE AT DRAGONFLIES

The government can help with childcare costs for parents.



Tax-free childcare

For working families, including self employed

Earning under £100k and an average of £183 per week each over 3 months

Who aren't receiving Tax Credits, Universal Credit or childcare vouchers

For every £8 you pay into an online account, the government will add an extra £2, up to £2,000 per child per year.

Tax Credits

For working families

70% of childcare costs, up to a cap

If you cannot make a new claim for Tax Credits, you may be able to apply for Universal Credit instead.

Universal Credit

For working families claiming Universal Credit

Up to 85% of eligible childcare costs

Who aren't receiving Tax-Free Childcare.

If you are studying

Help through your college if you are in further education

A weekly grant if you're in full-time higher education.
