The children jumped in and practised kicking their legs and moving their arms like they had learnt at swimming lessons. “I love my new armbands!” said Sam.

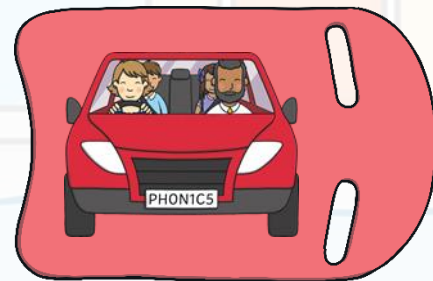
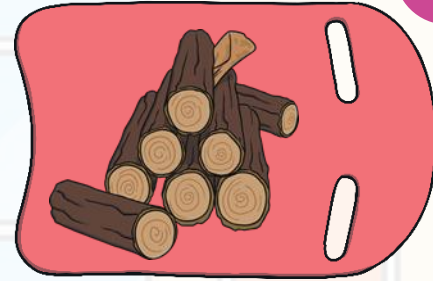
Pool Floats

In the deep end, there are lots of floats to play with, each one has a different word written on it. Can you read the words on the floats?

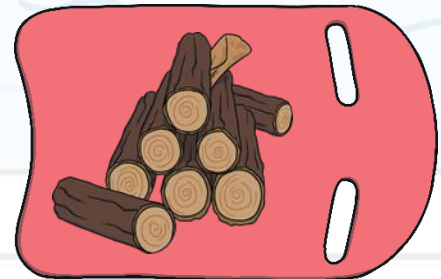
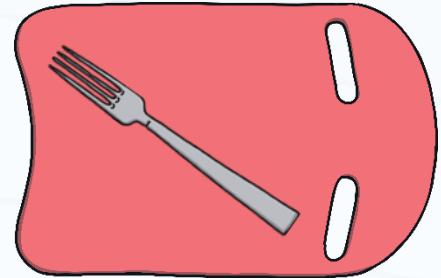
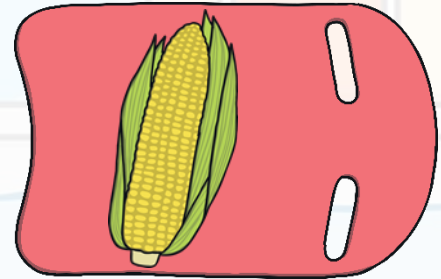
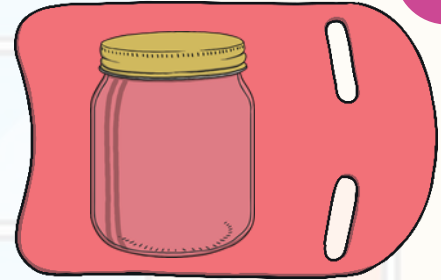
