


Today, we are recapping...

"I am going to make some wooden chairs to sell," said Sam. "We better get started!" said Mum and Dad.



Kit and Sam are making a banner for their stall. Can you help to write a word to match their pictures?










Caption Time


What did the recipe say was best to use for the buns? Write a caption or sentence to match the picture.
