We have already learned the sound for 'ch' however in some words it makes a /c/ sound.



Sometimes, when we see \mathbf{ch} , the \mathbf{h} is silent so we say /c/.


Christmas fair. I cannot wait!"






Click on the curtains to open them and reveal a word.

Can you read the words?






Shake a Bauble

Find and say all the words on the tree.










