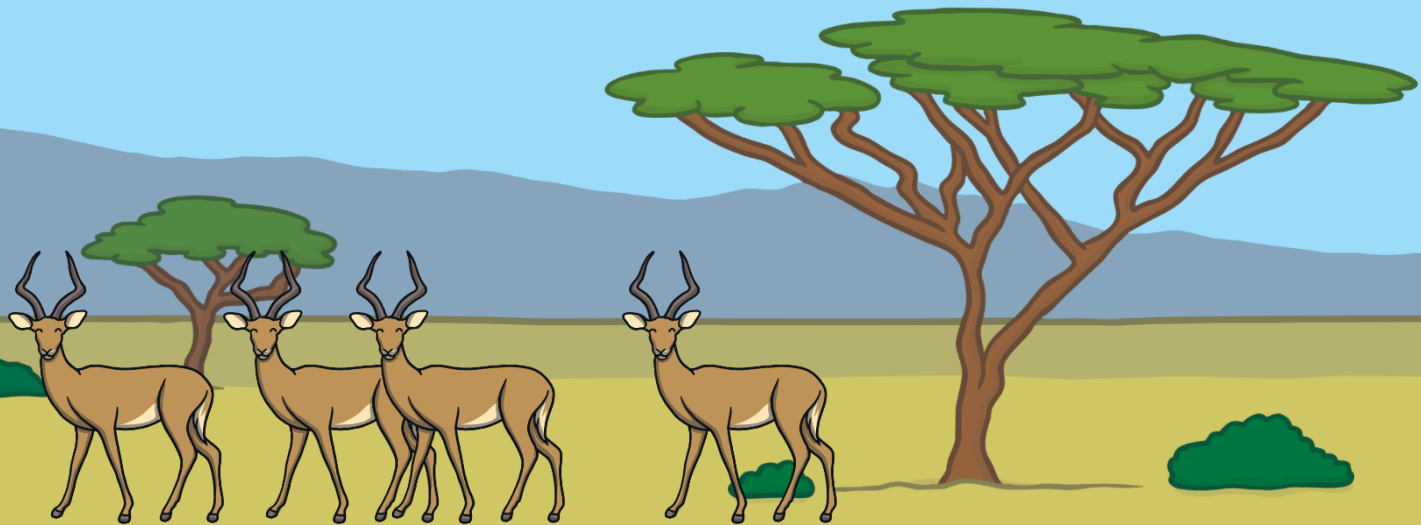

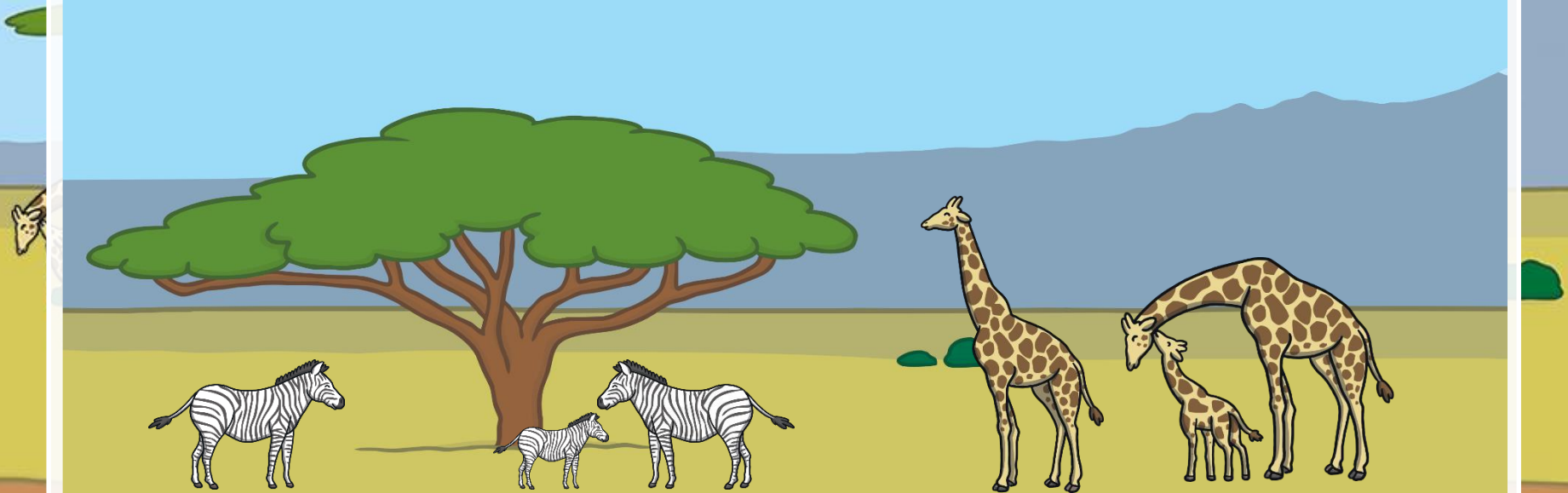


Who has **their** binoculars?
